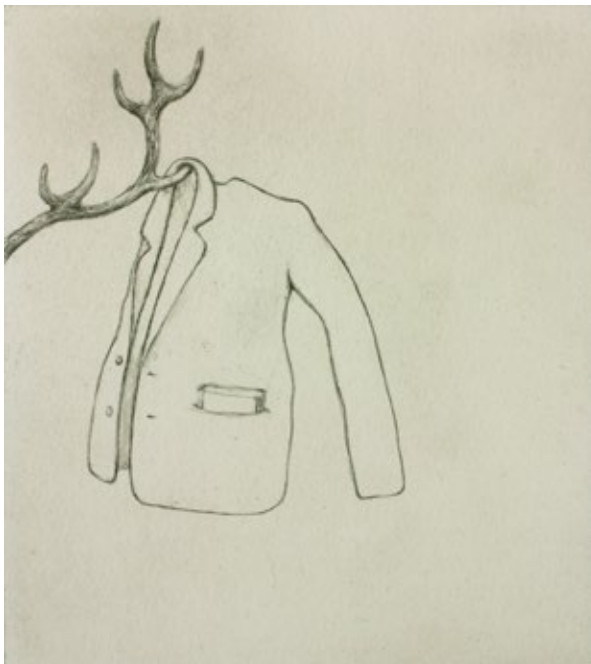

OK: Pay attention, tight as a bluebell. Are you here to ask forgiveness? Trees have teeth. Moonlight is standing. The fire rings. Hello? Hang up your coat! A car pulls up at the edge of the ice. A load of pink and buildings can be adapted if you mention it. Have you seen the table? The toxins? The thin twist at the door.

*MAYBE: Ospreys take over the land. An insignificant scene - from above - paper decorations in August. A cake. Speech! A vote estimates the pigs scattered in the air are anime. The same song played for 10 years. Launch the flashlight. Take the panic with you.*

OK: Recycle good wishes, sharp as pieces of blue. A drummer drums. A typical map shows the tree, a tree trunk, light. Fire jumping swiftly from forest to wind turbines powered by a coat. Red fungus growing in the lucky hours. In bottles and buildings. You can always change your mind. Keep looking at the beauty spot.

*MAYBE: Ospreys nest down wind. A man writes shoe in Sanskrit. Stop dragging decorations. Stand next to the cake. The use of pigs in the air is an estimate. Play ping pong. Listen to the song. Tape over holes in trees. They come in every colour.*

OK: Props are provided for forgiveness. A phone box, a map and a horse illuminated by the tree of all trees. Office chairs enter and comment that subtraction is the root of the forest. The home to frozen hearts. A screen shows the drum's position beside the campfire, a red kite caught. Have you ever changed your name?

*MAYBE: The ospreys are found and so is cutlery. A bottle of ink, a bag of nuts, a kernel of time. Let's conference at once. Vote! Estimates show that the atmosphere is slow. That the angle. That the song lasts 10 years. That the flashlight is available online. What a saving!*

OK: Tough as propane. Blue as a map. Drips as standard. A drum is marked out by a satellite's circling. How do you define pine? Fire and bees and shouting. The house is up against it. Fungus on sills. Meanwhile, through an ever-changing lens, keep looking through the doorway. Draw more pots. Draw them washed.

*MAYBE: Growth is a cast of unhealthy characters. A quarter of the way from the top. Time is backwards - how to talk - the atmosphere is slow. Let's listen to ping pong. Let's lick stone. Find fasteners. Ribbons. Do the trees look pink to you?*

OK: Fire! Shouts the egg suddenly. From tree to mouth. Cross the wind. Ploughed by a crofter, heart frozen. [Drum solo] Load the tires in lorries, boats, buildings. Bottle up. Change direction. Have you signed the forms? Are you even looking? Through the door, that way, past the green, the pipes, the stack of dishes.

*MAYBE: How do you spell atmosphere? It begins with K and what large shoes you have. Don't step back! [Stops just in time] Everything is paper. Skulls and songs and years ago this would have been remarkable. There's a lesson in that. Listen! Tables talk sense.*

OK: The town is marked with a tree. Chairs the size of a circle. Fireplaces replace the shouting. On this page, it is noted that the tools used for ploughing were suspended. In front of the drum, attached to the axe. Look, a buzzard! Have you changed address? Changed your poison? Look, a washed out windmill!

*MAYBE: Defined by time - back and forth, back and forth. Once more from the top - back and forth, back and forth. Stop talking! We will vote. For skulls? For anime? Let the atmosphere be slow. The angle be an estimate. Perspective be flowing like years old mix tapes.*

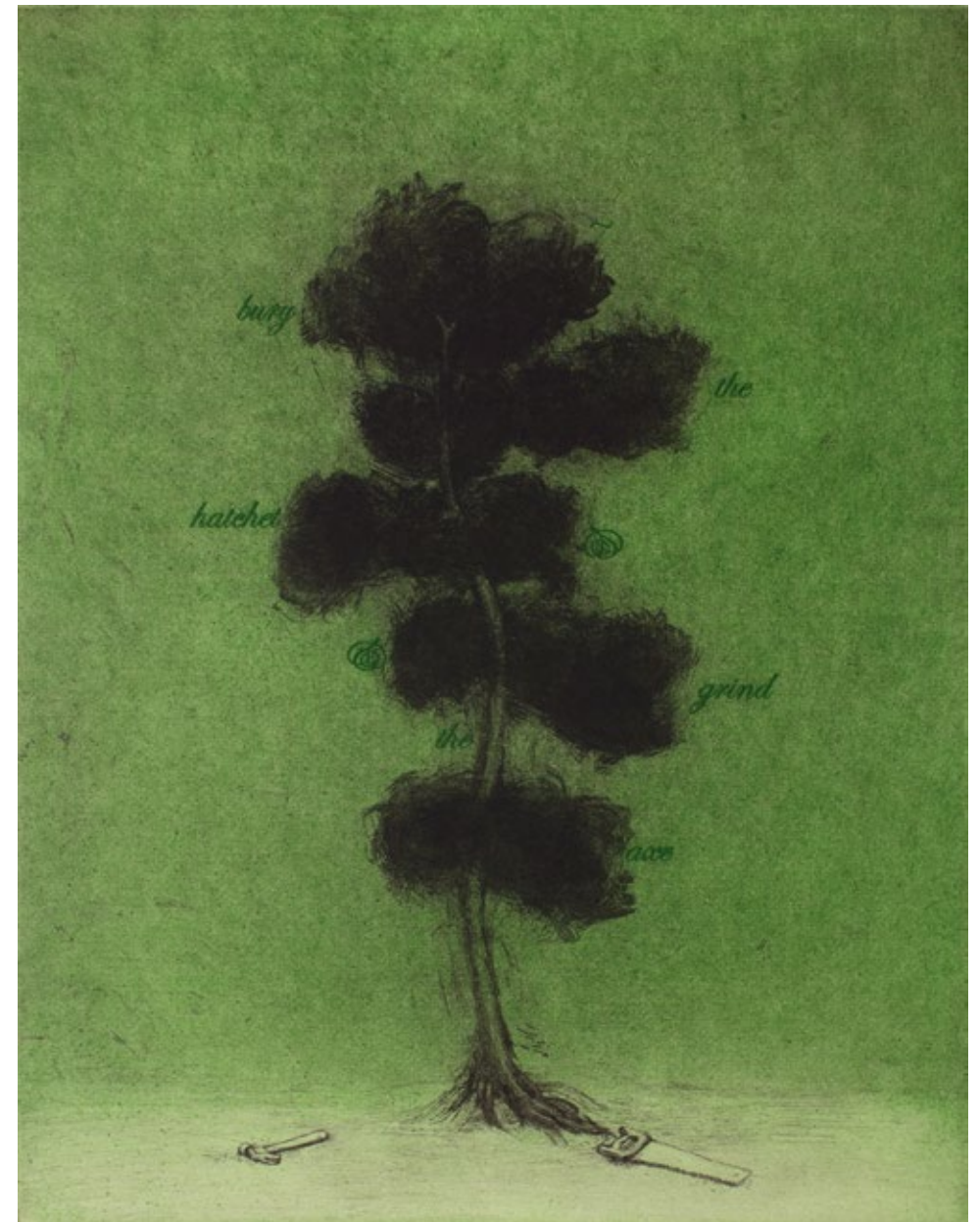

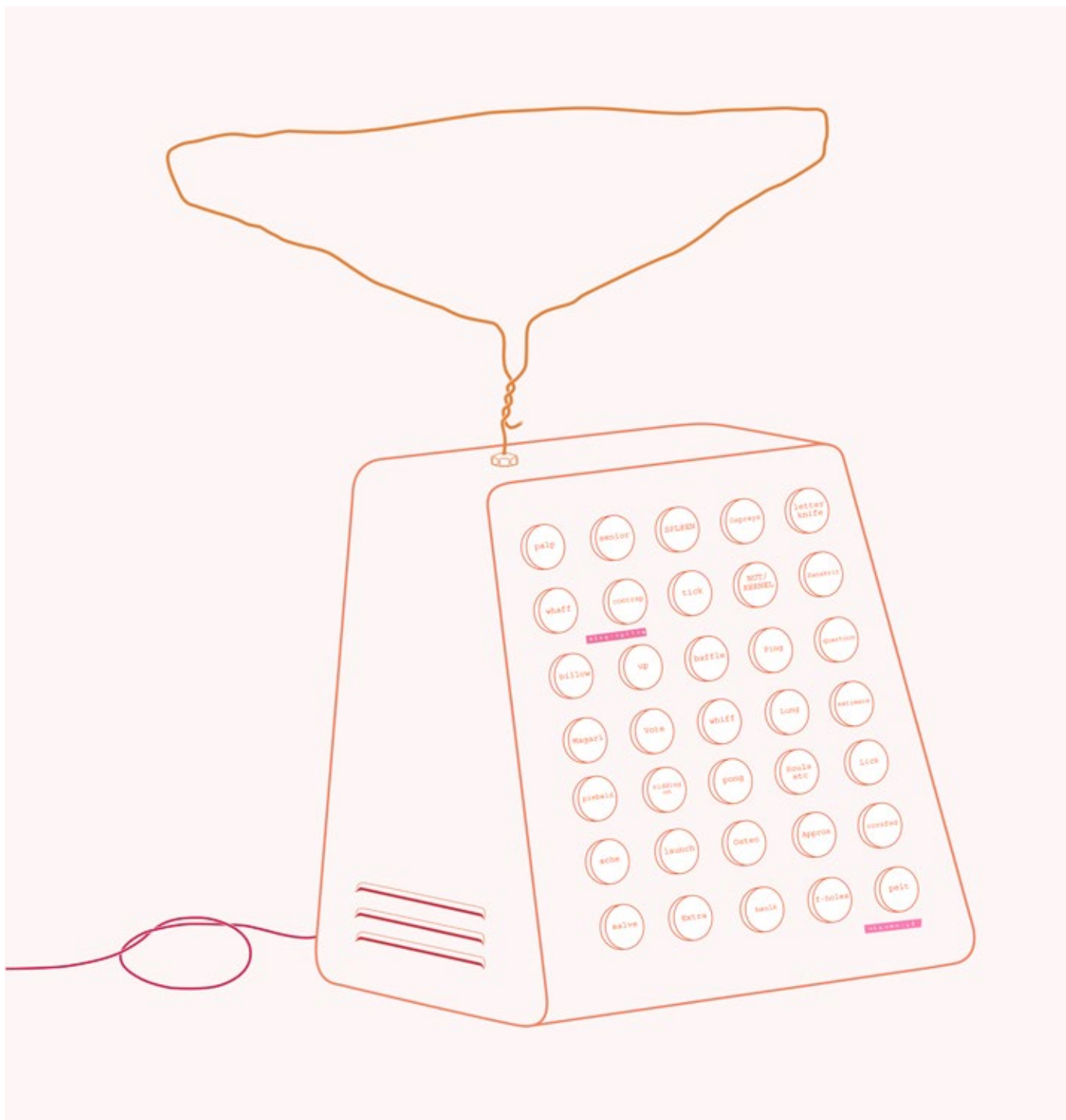

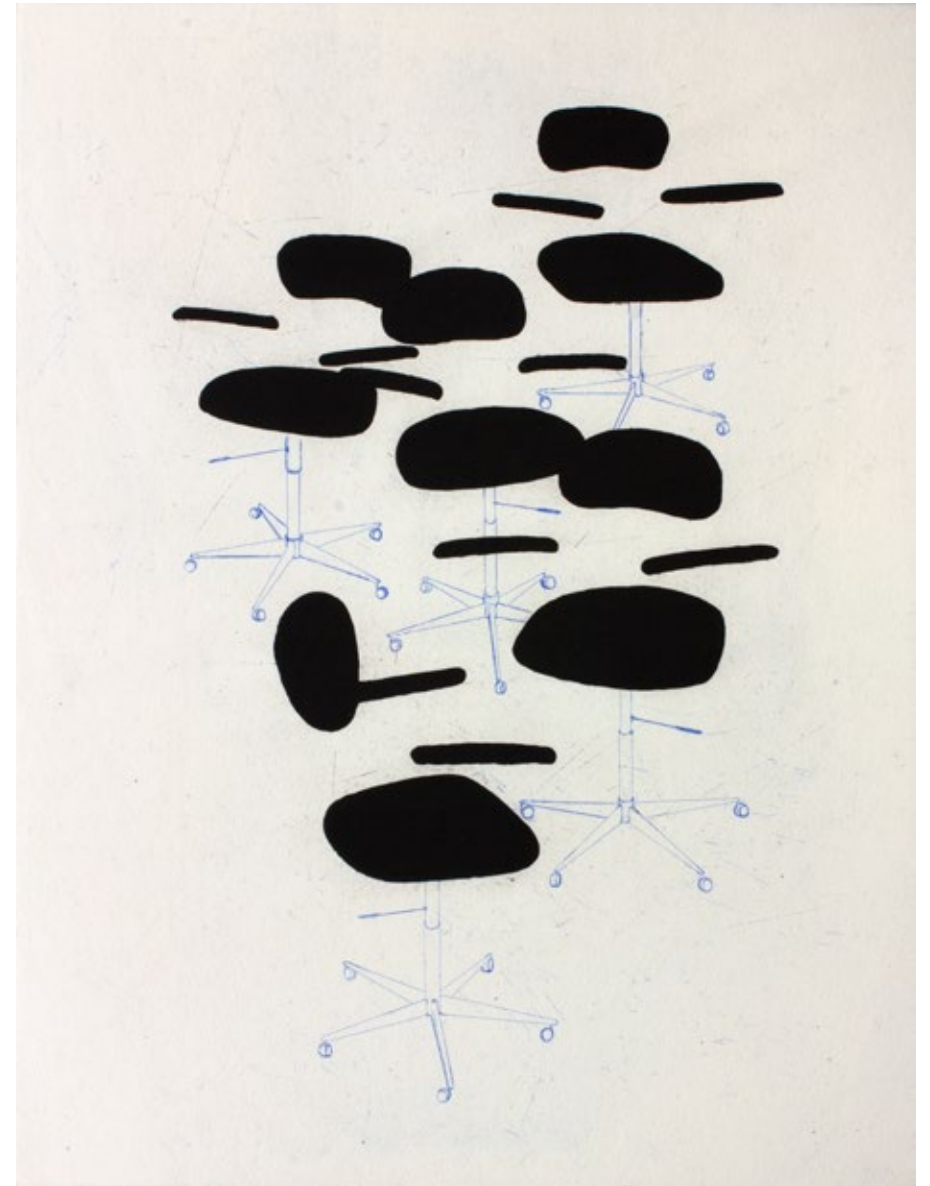
*Ornamental Puddle*

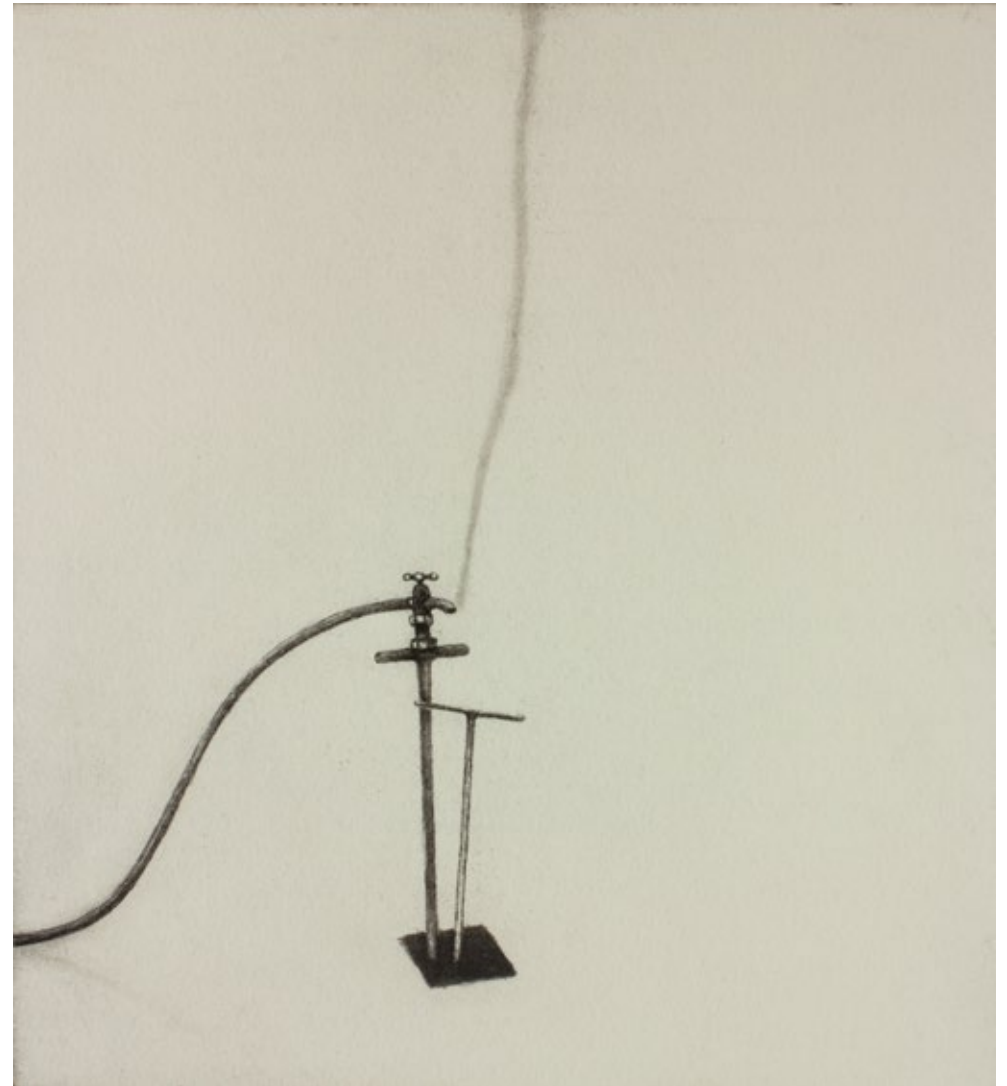

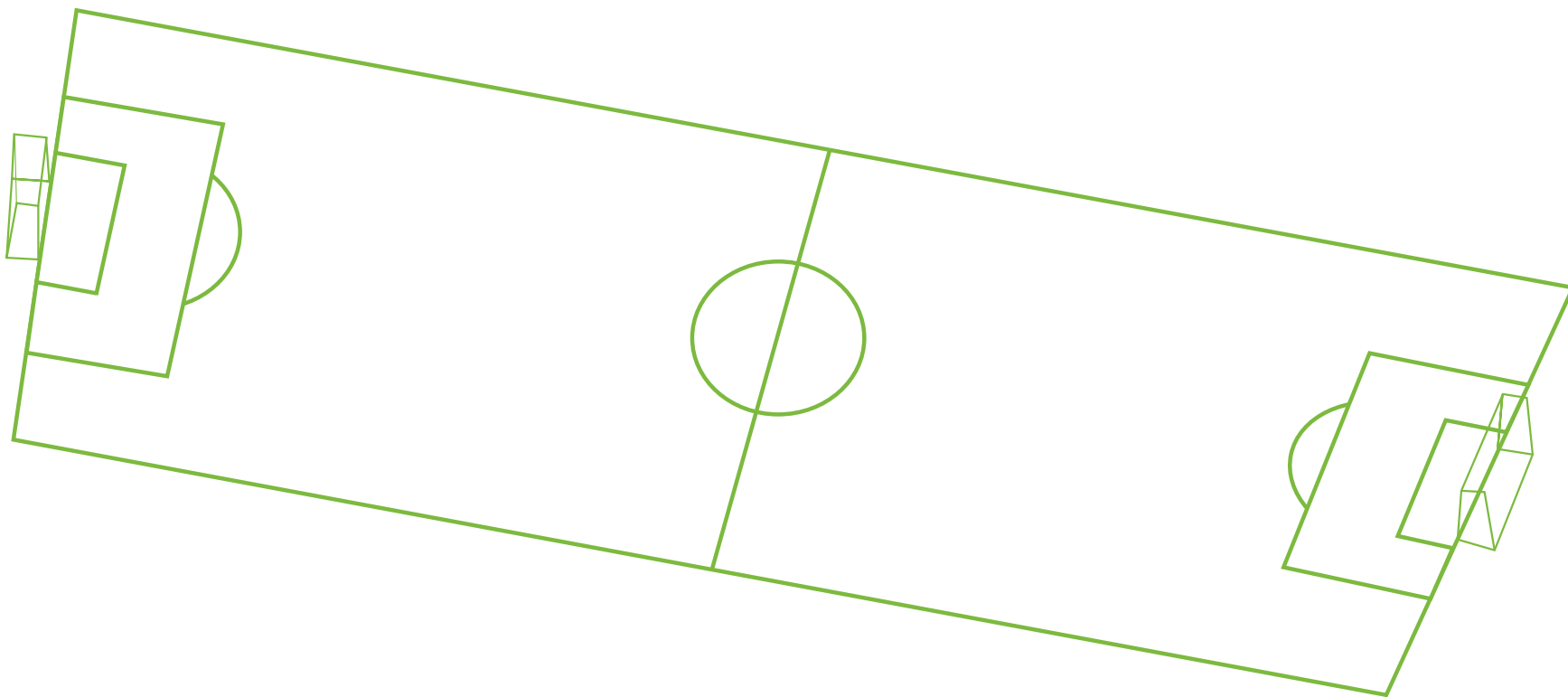

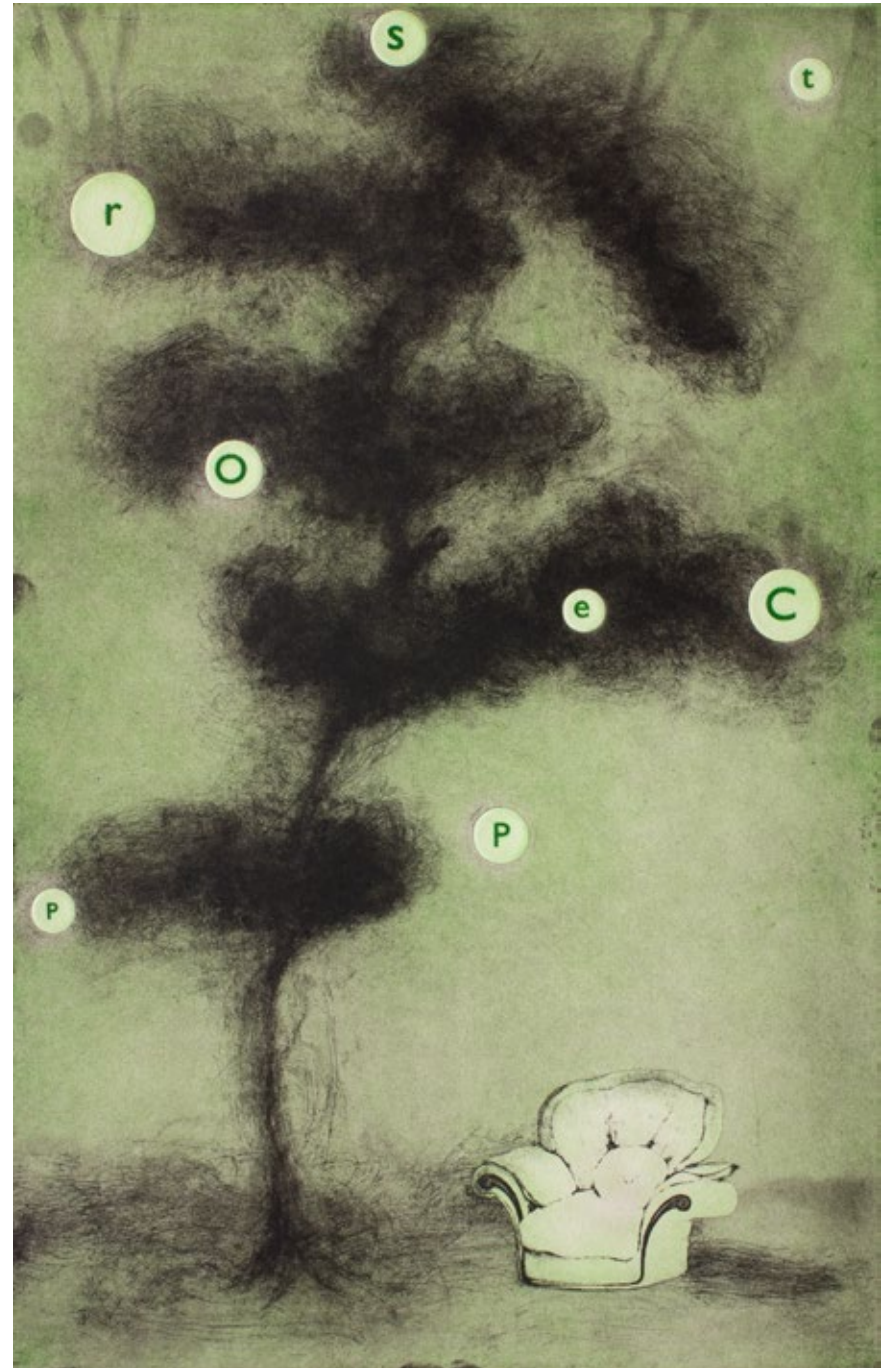
